RE: Travelling with VYALEV® (foslevodopa / foscarbidopa)

_____ is a patient under my care and is currently taking a medication that is given by continuous subcutaneous infusion.

VYALEV can be stored at a maximum of 30°C for a single period of up to 28 days in the original carton. Vials that are for use beyond 28 days should be stored and transported refrigerated (at 2°C to 8°C) and cannot be frozen. Therefore, this medication cannot be placed in check-in baggage as the temperature conditions in the cargo hold are not controlled.

_____ will be carrying the medication on board during this trip and may be carrying an AbbVie travel kit containing specially tested gel packs for temperature control. This medication is for their own personal use.
